ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Senior Recognition Program and Ceremony is designed to recognize and honor high school seniors for their academic accomplishments, extracurricular activities, community and civic service, leadership skills and talents.

Honorees will participate in activities that will help them transition from high school to the real world.

ELIGIBILITY

Students must be graduating high school seniors (Class of 2019) at the time of the program. Participating seniors cannot be parents. Seniors may reside outside of Tarrant County. Seniors may participate regardless of race, religion or national origin.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Seniors are given the opportunity to earn money for graduation and college expenses. Over the past 42 years, Beta Mu Omega has awarded close to \$400,000 in scholarships.

OBLIGATIONS

All seniors accepted into the program are required to attend all workshops, service projects and the Ceremony. Each senior will have a minimum amount of funds to raise through activities such as sponsorships and ticket sales.

- Become familiar with the college admissions program including applying for financial aid, housing, etc.
- Understand guidelines for writing strong essays, particularly for scholarships and college admissions
- Understand the process for building a successful business
